




# 1 Minor Form Changes

Service / Form	Change
<b>Breast</b>	Reason for Referral: Lump Add 'Other' before Lump Details to make 'Other Lump Details' as most information has been collected in drop down boxes above this
<b>Diabetes</b>	Reason for Referral: Retinal Screening Make 'main issues' non mandatory only for reason for referral: Retinal Screening
<b>Fertility</b>	Reason for Referral: Infertility Investigations/Results to be attached needs to include: 'Progesterone level 6-8 days before menses'
<b>Gastroenterology - Endoscopy</b>	Reason for Referral: Colonoscopy If Colonoscopy is selected there should be an Iron Deficiency Anaemia option. Same content as for reason for referral 'Gastroscopy' as below, including '?' Healthpoint link) 
<b>General Surgery - Colorectal</b>	General Surgery Colorectal - Colonoscopy Request>Suspected Colorectal Cancer>Investigations Details is limited to 200 char – make 1000
<b>General Surgery Other</b>	Change 'Reason for referral' field to a dropdown (mandatory). Dropdown to contain options: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hernia</li> <li>• Other</li> </ul> <p>If dropdown 'Hernia' is selected hernia details below will display (as they do when GP ticks 'hernia' box today.</p> <p>If dropdown 'Other' is selected, field other referral reason will display.</p>
<b>Haematology</b>	David Simpson, WDHb clinician is not happy with Haematology referrals as he can get 6 pages of attachments. For each reason for referral the form lists 'investigations/results to be attached'. So GPs are sending in lots of lab results/attachments.  Please replace on form 'investigations/results to be attached' with 'Please ensure the following tests have been done (only attach results for tests not performed by Auckland

	laboratories)'. 
<b>Ophthalmology</b>	'Without glasses: right' and 'without glasses:left' should be mandatory
<b>Paediatric Medicine</b>	<p>Field 'Referral To' should default to option 'Paediatric General Medicine'. Remove 'Please Select'.</p> 
<b>Paediatric Surgery: Urology, Thoracic, GI/HPB'</b>	<p>Select any reason for referral</p> <p>Remove all 'Condition detail ' text boxes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Abdomen condition detail</li> <li>• Anal condition detail</li> <li>• Chest condition detail</li> <li>• Genitalia condition detail</li> <li>• Head and neck condition detail</li> <li>• Inguinal and scrotal condition detail</li> <li>• Limbs' condition detail</li> <li>• Paediatric gynaecology details</li> <li>• Skin and subcutaneous condition detail</li> <li>• Urinary tract condition detail</li> </ul>
<b>Respiratory</b>	<p>J Sood (WDHB Respiratory Clinician) has advised full X ray report should be attached.</p> <p>For all options add text to form 'Please attach chest Xray report if available'.</p>
<b>Women's Health Obstetrics and Maternity</b>	<p>Field 'Fetal Growth Assessment' should not be mandatory</p> <p>Field 'Parity' should be changed from numeric to free text (as GPs enter P1, P2, etc)</p>
<b>Womens Health - Gynaecology</b>	<p>Remove the field:</p> <p>Hb g/L (Normal range 115-160 g/L ' for all 'Reasons for Referral' EXCEPT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Post Menopausal Bleeding</li> <li>• Heavy Menstrual Bleeding</li> <li>• Suspected Gynaecological Malignancy</li> </ul>
